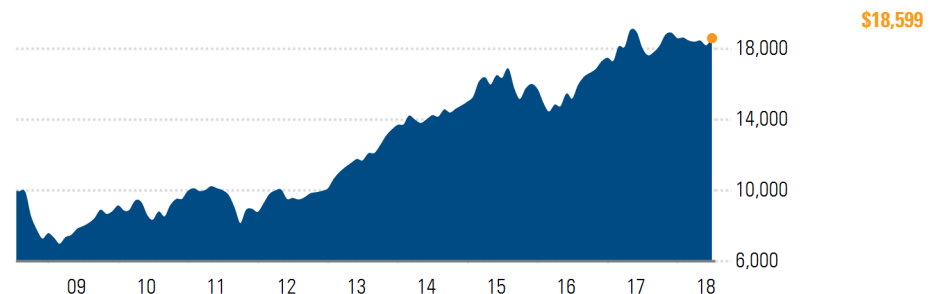
Investment Objective
